Target Population

Likely voters; Georgia May 24 primary; Griffin Judicial Circuit

Sampling Method

Registered voters determined likely to vote in the Georgia primary were selected randomly from a voter database. Likely voters were contacted on the evening of January 25th, 2016 using an interactive voice response system.

Weighting

The survey sample was weighted using propensity scores for age, race, gender, political affiliation, and county, according to 2014 primary turnout data.
